

Master of Autism Studies 4+1 Application

Saint Mary's College juniors may apply to the Master of Autism Studies program during the junior year. If admitted to the graduate program, you will complete two graduate courses the summer before your senior year and one to two graduate courses during your senior year prior to baccalaureate graduation. You will continue Autism Studies courses in the fall term following your baccalaureate graduation and continue for the next spring and summer terms to complete the bachelors and graduate degree in five years. In the fifth year, you will be charged the per credit hour rate equivalent to the cohort you are joining.
